Multiuse food-contact surfaces shall be:                      (A) smooth;                      (B) free of breaks, open seams, cracks, chips, inclusions, pits, and similar imperfections;                      (C) free of sharp internal angles, corners, and crevices;                      (D) finished to have smooth welds and joints; and                      (E) except as specified in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, accessible for cleaning and inspection by one of the following methods:                      (i) without being disassembled;                      (ii) by disassembling without the use of tools; or                      (iii) by easy disassembling with the use of handheld tools commonly available to maintenance and cleaning personnel such as screwdrivers, pliers, and wrenches. (ii) the system is self-draining or capable of being completely drained of cleaning and sanitizing solutions; and

To Wit: Single service, single use and clean sanitized cups and cup lids stored in the under drain of handwash sink are exposed to splash, dust, or other contamination. (Corrected 08/11/10)

To Correct: Single service, single use and clean sanitized utensils must be stored where they are not exposed to splash, dust, or other contamination and at least six (6) inches above the floor. Corrections must be made immediately.
