2	<p>Texas food Establishment Rules</p> <p>Page 60 §229.164(o)(6) Potentially hazardous food, hot and cold holding. Except during preparation, cooking, or cooling, or when time is used as the public health control as specified under paragraph (9) of this subsection, and except as specified in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, potentially hazardous food shall be maintained:</p> <p>(A) at 57 degrees Celsius (135 degrees Fahrenheit) or above, except that roasts cooked to a temperature and for a time specified in subsection (k)(1)(B) of this section or reheated as specified in subsection (m)(2)(E) of this section may be held at a temperature of 54 degrees Celsius (130 degrees Fahrenheit) or above; or</p>

(B) at a temperature specified in the following:

(i) 5 degrees Celsius (41 degrees Fahrenheit) or less; or

(ii) 7 degrees Celsius (45 degrees Fahrenheit) or less in countertop, under-counter and open-top refrigeration units located in the food preparation area that were in use prior to October 6, 2003, provided the food is date marked as specified in paragraphs (7)-(9) of this subsection.

(C) Shell eggs that have not been treated to destroy all viable Salmonellae shall be stored in refrigerated equipment that maintains an ambient air temperature of 7 degrees Celsius (45 degrees Fahrenheit) or less.

To Wit: The poultry product is at room temperature sitting in a sink of water is not being maintained at 41/45 degrees F or below. (Corrected 01/25/10)

To Correct: Discard the poultry product that is not being maintained at 41/45 degrees F or below. Corrections must be made immediately.

You have to have water running constantly during this type of thaw.

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229.163 (n)

Eating, drinking, or using tobacco.

(1) Except as specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection, an employee shall eat, drink, or use any form of tobacco only in designated areas where the contamination of exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; unwrapped single-service and single-use articles; or other items needing protection cannot result.

(2) A food employee may drink from a closed beverage container if the container is handled to prevent contamination of:

(A) the employee's hands;

(B) the container; and

(C) exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; and unwrapped single-service and single-use articles.

(o) Discharges from the eyes, nose, and mouth. Food employees experiencing persistent sneezing, coughing, or a runny nose that causes discharges from the eyes, nose, or mouth may

not work with exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; or unwrapped single-service

or single-use articles.

(p) Hair restraints, effectiveness.

(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, food employees shall wear hair restraints such as hats, hair coverings or nets, beard restraints, and clothing that covers

body hair, that are designed and worn to effectively keep their hair from contacting exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; and unwrapped single-service and single-use articles.

(2) This section does not apply to food employees such as counter staff who only serve beverages and wrapped or packaged foods, hostesses, and wait staff if they present a minimal risk of contaminating exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; and unwrapped single-service and single-use articles.

(q) Handling prohibition.

**CODE****DESCRIPTION**

(1) Except as specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection, food employees may not care for or handle animals that may be present such as patrol dogs, service animals, or pets that are allowed as specified in §229.167(p)(15)(B)(ii)-(v) of this title (relating to Physical Facilities).

(2) Food employees with assistance animals may handle or care for their assistance animals and food employees may handle or care for fish in aquariums or molluscan shellfish or crustacea in display tanks if they wash their hands as specified under subsections (f) and (h)(3) of this section.

To Wit: The food service worker's hair is not restrained while preparing/handling food or contacting clean food contact surfaces. (Corrected 01/25/10)

To Correct: The food service worker's hair must be restrained while preparing/handling food or contacting clean food contact surfaces. Corrections must be made immediately.

(e) Handwashing facilities.

(1) Minimum number. Handwashing facilities shall be provided as specified under §229.166(g)(1) of this title.

(2) Handwashing cleanser, availability. Each handwashing lavatory or group of 2 adjacent lavatories shall be provided with a supply of hand cleaning liquid, powder, or bar soap.

(3) Hand drying provision. Each handwashing lavatory or group of adjacent lavatories shall be provided with:

(A) individual, disposable towels;

(B) a continuous towel system that supplies the user with a clean towel; or

(C) a heated-air hand drying device.

To Wit: No hand soap provisions were available at the handwash facilities in the food preparation area. (Corrected 01/25/10)

To Correct: Hand soap provisions must be available at the handwash facilities in the food preparation area. Corrections must be made immediately.

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§229.165(d)

(d) Cleanability.

(1) Food-contact surfaces. Multiuse food-contact surfaces shall be:

(A) smooth;

(B) free of breaks, open seams, cracks, chips, inclusions, pits, and similar imperfections;

(C) free of sharp internal angles, corners, and crevices;

(D) finished to have smooth welds and joints; and

(E) except as specified in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, accessible for cleaning and inspection by one of the following methods:

	(i) without being disassembled; (ii) by disassembling without the use of tools; or (iii) by easy disassembling with the use of handheld tools commonly available to maintenance and cleaning personnel such as screwdrivers, pliers, and wrenches. (2) Paragraph (5) of this subsection does not apply to cooking oil storage tanks, distribution lines for cooking oils, or beverage syrup lines or tubes. (3) Cleaned in place (CIP) equipment. (A) CIP equipment shall meet the characteristics specified under paragraph (1) of this subsection and shall be designed and constructed so that: (i) cleaning and sanitizing solutions circulate throughout a fixed system and contact all interior food-contact surfaces; and (ii) the system is self-draining or capable of being completely drained of cleaning and sanitizing solutions; and
To Wit:	The bakers oven door is broken, cannot close door properly located in the food preparation area is cracked, chipped, bent or broken and cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized.
To Correct:	The bakers oven door is broken, cannot close door properly located in the food preparation area must be free of cracks, chips, bends or breaks to permit it to be properly cleaned and sanitized. Corrections must be made immediately.
To Wit:	The ovens, microwave and can opener located in the food preparation area has adhering food or food particles. (Corrected 01/25/10)
To Correct:	The ovens, microwave and can opener located in the food preparation area must be properly washed, rinsed and sanitized and free of food or food particles. Corrections must be made immediately.
